


Frequently Asked Questions About Parking




Proper Placement of the



Parking Permit



TRUCKS & AUTOS: Right rear window or suspended from mirror.
 *For tinted rear window, put on lower right front window, passenger side.
MOTORCYCLES, MOPEDS, SCOOTERS: Front fender or fork.



1. Does Copper Mountain College have parking and traffic regulations? Yes, Board Policy 7190 and Administrative Regulations. **(Admin Reg. 7190)**

2. Do I have to purchase a parking permit to park at CMC? Yes, parking permits are required to park on Campus. **(Admin Reg. 7190.1.A)**

3. Do I need to purchase a permit for each vehicle I own? Yes, additional permits may be purchased for \$1.00 for each additional vehicle upon proof of ownership. **(Admin Reg. 7190.1.F)**

4. Can I park in the dirt or in any unimproved areas on Campus? **NO.** Parking is only authorized in the permitted areas as indicated on the campus map. **(Admin Reg. 7190.7.A)**

5. Do I have to place the Parking Permit on my window? No, you may purchase a Parking Permit hanger for \$1.00, which hangs on your mirror. Remember to put it up every day, you may be cited for not having it properly displayed. **(Admin Reg. 7190.1.C)**

6. I have a Disabled Placard/ Plate; do I need to purchase a parking permit? Yes, both the placard and parking permit must be properly displayed. **(Admin Reg. 7190.3.C)**

7. I lost my Parking Permit, or it was stolen, can I get it replaced? Yes. A \$5.00 fee will be charged for replacement of lost permits. You must provide proof of being a permit holder. **(Admin Reg. 7190.1.E)**

8. I forgot to hang my permit and received a citation, what do I need to do? You may either pay the \$20.00 fine or file an Appeal. Appeal forms are available in the Business Office. **(Admin Reg. 7190.5.F)**

9. What happens if I do not pay the citation? Failure to respond to a citation within 30 days will result in the fine being increased to \$40.00 and a "hold" being placed upon your academic records. **(Admin Reg. 7190.5.E)**

10. What happens if my car is in the shop and I have a rental or borrow my friend's car? You may get a Temporary Parking Permit at no cost from Student Services, Business Office or a Security Officer with proof of being permit holder. **(Admin Reg. 7190.2.A)**

11. I sold my vehicle, how can I get a Parking permit for my new vehicle? A replacement may be purchased for \$1.00 upon presentation of the original permit. **(Admin Reg. 7190.1.E)**

12. I have car trouble, can I get any assistance? **LIMITED.** Security will only jump start your car if the battery is dead. Any other problem you will need to call for assistance. You can request use of a phone book from the Business Office. (You must sign a release of Liability Form for jump start)

13. Can security get into locked cars? **NO.** Security will only access a vehicle if it is left running, or child or animal is in car. Contact the Business Office or Security for a list of lock smiths in the area.

14. Is there a Speed Limit in the parking lot? Yes, there is a **10 MPH** speed limit, however; you need to drive at a safe speed for all conditions consistent with traffic and pedestrian conditions. Speeders will be cited on first offense. **(Admin Reg. 7190.6.A)**

15. Are there enough parking spaces on Campus? Yes, there is adequate number of parking spaces; however CMCCD does not guarantee a parking space.

16. Can I park in the visitor's lot? Only if you are just visiting the campus and you only park in the visitor lot for the designated time limit. **(Admin Reg. 7190.9)**

17. How do I contact Security? You can go to the Business Services Office and have them radioed or press the "Security" button on any of the campus pay phones. Each Campus office phone has a Security speed dial button too.

18. Where can I go to get other questions answered that I may have? You may view the Administrative Regulation on the CMC's Web Site at www.cmccd.edu . You may also speak with Security or the Supervisor Maintenance and Operations to get your questions answered.

19. Can I park my motorcycle in a parking space? **NO.** Motorcycles may only be parked in designated motorcycle parking areas, of which there are two. At the Eastern foot of the main stairs from the upper parking lot to Phase I and on the Western edge of the main walkway from the lower parking lot into Phase III
