



Jeannie Clery Act Reportable incidents from January 1st to December 31st, 2011

January 2011

1/11/2011 – 1000hrs. Staff at the General Reid Bookstore arrived to find pry marks on their main door. A possible forced entry was attempted but, not completed. Sheriff Department was notified.

February 2011

2/4/2011 – 0800hrs. Several reports from campus employees of several students fighting near the bus stop located in Phase II. The subjects dispersed prior to Security being on duty. No witnesses were located.

2/24/2011 – 0900hrs. CMC IS employees reported the theft of a hard drive from a computer in the computer lab in room 220. There were no witnesses. Sheriff Department was notified.

March 2011

3/16/2011 - 1230hrs. A female student advised 2 female students had repeatedly threatened her with physical harm on several occasions and had become more verbally threatening. The female students were identified and interviewed by the Vice President of Student Services. They were ultimately expelled.

April 2011

4/28/2011 – 0845hrs. A GPS device was stolen from an unlocked vehicle in the parking lot of the Student Success center. There were no witnesses to the theft. The victim chose to not report the theft to the Sheriff Department.

May 2011

5/6/2011 – 1221hrs. CMC Custodian reported the female hygiene dispenser in Student Services had approximately \$10.00 worth of quarters stolen from it. There were no witnesses to the theft. It was not reported to the Sheriff Department.

June 2011

July 2011

7/27/2011 – 1645hrs. A male student made verbal threats to Admissions and Records staff via telephone. The student was interviewed by the Vice President of Student Services and was expelled from campus.

August 2011

8/3/2011 – 1200hrs. A vendor vehicle was involved in a single vehicle vs. property automobile collision in CMC main parking lot. The delivery truck struck and damaged a fire hydrant.

8/25/2011 – 1240hrs. A CMC instructor notified campus security of a male student acting “odd” in her class. Security contacted the student and determined the student suffered from several mental disorders



and was not current on his medication. The student agreed to leave campus to go to Morongo Basin Mental Health for assistance.

September 2011

9/19/2011 – 1110hrs. A female juvenile student reported she was receiving unwanted advancements from an adult male student on campus after repeatedly being told her age (16) and being told to stop. The male student was identified and contacted by the Vice President of Student Services. He was expelled from campus. The Sheriff Department was notified and conducted an investigation for PC 647.6, annoying/harassing a child.

October 2011

10/6/2011 – 1155hrs. A male student arrived on campus intoxicated and was disrupting class. Security contacted the student to proceed to argue with, threaten and attempt to fight the security officer. The Sheriff Department was notified and arrested the subject without incident.

10/13/2011 – 0945hrs. A female transient was on campus causing a disturbance. The female was a habitual disturbance on campus. She was contacted and escorted off campus by Security. She was advised she would be arrested for trespassing upon her return.

10/25/2011 – 0915hrs. A 2 vehicle, non-injury, traffic collision occurred in the CMC main parking lot. Property damage only.

November 2011

12/9/2011 – 1200hrs. A female student was indirectly threatened by another female student on campus. The victim was counseled by security and the Vice President of Student Services. The victim opted to not complete the report and wanted no further action taken.
