I. New Business

a. Call for Participation in OEI (Z. Ginder)

Mr. Ginder reported that there have been a number of emails regarding the pilot program to direct transfer back to a home college to get a degree in a more expeditious manner. Mr. Ginder does not know if this is something the district would like to consider and requested feedback. An inquiry was made regarding qualifications for this pilot program. There are issues with articulation and multiple departments that would need to be involved. Dr. Kersey clarified that the group working on the pilot would be determining the rules for this project. A number of issues and concerns were expressed including taking courses with us for another school, articulation, possible gain or loss of FTES was mentioned. We are a small college without the breadth of classes of larger schools. If we are a teaching college in addition to a home college we need to increase the numbers of online class offerings. There is some interest, but there is also skepticism about how it would work. Infrastructure built into the program? It was pointed out that the interest survey is not binding. The recommendation was that Mr. Ginder attend the webinar and see if this is something we wish to consider. Dr. Kersey noted we might be able to boost FTES in this manner. Spaces are available as a rural community college that students need.

II. Old Business

a. AP 6750 – Parking and Traffic Regulations (M. Plummer)

Ms. Plummer mentioned the proper document was sent out again. Ms. Alpin sent information from the Classified Senate. Ms. Hopkins brought forth concerns from Ms. Schiel and the Academic Senate. One concern was link to DMV, 4th page item 6, skateboarding and roller skating – F under enforcement and recommended deleting bullets. Another concern was that this does not seem appropriate to an AP. Appeal of ticket guidelines was suggested. General comment that there used to be directional arrows in the parking lot. Consensus was to make changes and move forward with this item.

b. DE Updates (Z. Ginder)

Mr. Ginder reported that faculty satisfaction surveys for instructors who teach online will be available shortly. He is presently working with Jacob regarding the pool that will be used for this purpose. Information will be uploaded to the Chancellor's Office. He has a meeting scheduled next week regarding departmental questions. Mr. Ginder distributed Minimum Faculty Readiness Criterion for Online Instruction and reviewed changes that will be included with next draft. Feedback is welcome. AP 4105 Distance Education is under development and will be available for review soon.

III. Other/Discussion

Ms. Hopkins mentioned Ms. Schiel was surprised yesterday that the new student scorecard data was shared with the Board prior to the Academic Senate and Curriculum Committee. There were changes in scorecard data and there might be explanations of why and different groups may have input. Concern was expressed regarding student success under 10+1.

Changes were recommended regarding credit by exam including catalog and other items that may be affected as a result.

Mr. Kevari mentioned he will be sending out survey information.
