



# EMT and Nursing Programs At Copper Mountain College

## Emergency Medical Technician (Basic) Certificate Program

**Must complete Info Session and submit pre-enrollment document packet prior to registration**

This Program includes theory instruction, skills practice and supervised field/clinical time in selected pre-hospital sites. Upon successful completion of the Program (student **must** maintain an 80% average throughout the Program), the student is eligible to take the NREMT-Basic exam and apply to the local EMS Authority. County-issued certification as an EMT (Basic) is valid for 2 years.

- Must be 18 years old on first day of class
- 6.5 units (72 hours classroom, 91 hours lab, 44 hours field/clinical); 15 seats each offering
- Program offered in two formats
  - Semester format [16 weeks]
  - Accelerated format [8 weeks]
- Approximate cost: \$1760.00
- **NO ABSENCES OR TARDINESS ALLOWED**

## Nurse Assistant Certificate Program

**Must complete Info Session and submit pre-enrollment document packet prior to registration**

This Program includes basic nursing principles used in the care of clients in long term care facilities. Successful completion of the Program results in eligibility to take the State-approved exam that leads to certification. Certification exam consists of written exam and practicum following completion of course.

- Must be 16 years old on first day of class (concurrent enrollment in high school allowed)
- 6 units (72 hours classroom, 100 hours clinical); 15 seats each offering
- 12 week Program
- Approximate cost: \$1725.00
- **NO ABSENCES OR TARDINESS ALLOWED**

## Home Health Aide Certificate Program

**Must complete Info Session and submit pre-enrollment document packet prior to registration**

This Program expands on the content taught in the Nurse Assistant Program to provide preparation for care of residents in home care settings.

- Must be a California Certified Nurse Assistant
- 2 units (27 hours classroom, 27 hours clinical); 15 seats each offering
- 6 week Program
- Approximate cost: \$1271.00 (lower if HHA Program completed immediately following NA Program)
- **NO ABSENCES OR TARDINESS ALLOWED**

## Vocational Nursing Certificate/Associate Degree Program

**Applications accepted February 1 to February 28**

- Must be high school graduate or have GED
- Prerequisites: Anatomy (CMC BI-022), Physiology (CMC BI-023), Developmental Psychology (CMC PSY-003), Basic Pharmacology (CMC HS-065)
- ALL Prerequisite coursework must be completed within five (5) years of application to the Program
- 1 year program (Summer, Fall and Spring semesters); 15 students admitted each admission cycle
- No waiting list – applicants not admitted to the Program must reapply to be considered for admission

- Approximate cost of program: \$5200.00

**Registered Nursing  
Associate Degree Program**

**Applications accepted October 1 to October 31**

- Must be high school graduate or have GED
- Prerequisites: Anatomy (CMC BI-022), Physiology (CMC BI-023), Microbiology (CMC BI-015), College Composition (CMC ENG-003A), Developmental Psychology (CMC PSY-003), Intermediate Algebra (CMC MATH-040) with grade of "B" or better in each course
- ALL prerequisite coursework must be completed within seven (7) years of application to the Program
- Detailed admission policy is posted on Health Sciences page of CMC website)
- 2 year program (Fall & Spring, Summer off, Fall & Spring); 24 students admitted each admission cycle
- No waiting list – applicants not admitted to the Program must reapply to be considered for admission
- Approximate cost of program: \$5900.00

**Registered Nursing – LVN to RN, Military Challenge  
Associate Degree Program**

- Must be high school graduate or have GED
- Prerequisites: Anatomy (CMC BI-022), Physiology (CMC BI-023), Microbiology (CMC BI-015), College Composition (CMC ENG-003A), Developmental Psychology (CMC PSY-003), Intermediate Algebra (CMC MATH-040) with grade of "B" or better in each course
- ALL prerequisite coursework must be completed within nine (9) years of application to the Program
- Detailed admission policy is posted on Health Sciences page of CMC website)
- No waiting list – applicants not admitted to the Program must reapply to be considered for admission
- Approximate cost of program: \$5200.00
