Tutoring center will be in the library.

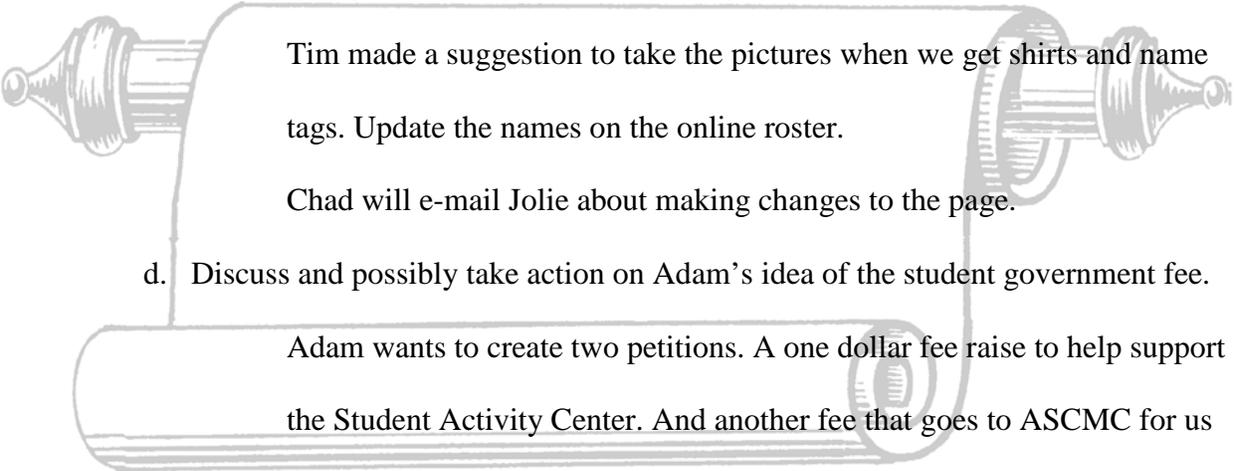
Adam-
