a. Jeff Cummings - President Cummings spoke about campus safety, he takes safety seriously and enforcing safety is a campus focus. Reality of a harmful situation is a person will try to do harm and the President will do what he and other staff can to save lives. A lock down drill is coming up soon, PA software has failed before but now they are checking it monthly. There are messages for that PA system for lock downs and evacuation drills. Some buildings do not have deadbolts on the doors, but they are working to ensure that doors have manual locks. The buildings have numbers, next they are trying to place numbers on the roofs in case of aerial support. There is a challenge to communicate based on viable threats, staff do not want to scare students. Last Thursday was an example of telling students about a safety issue on campus, students were texted, emailed, and notified over the PA system. Transit and sheriffs were called to ensure students would be able to leave despite the dust particulates. Security should be present in emergency situations, and should be granted authority to perform duties in specific cases and possibly be trained in "perishable skills."
