Student Tax Filers VERIFICATION If you filed taxes:

Check the box that applies:

- The student has used the **IRS DRT** in **FAFSA on the Web** to transfer 2018 IRS income tax return information into the student's FAFSA.

 1. A 2018 IRS Tax Return Transcript (does not need to be signed), **and**

- The student was required to file a 2018 IRS tax return and has been granted a **Filing Extension** by the IRS, must provide:
 1. A copy of IRS Form 4868, "Application for Automatic Extension of Time to File U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS for tax year 2018;
 2. A copy of the IRS's approval of an extension beyond the automatic six-month extension for tax year 2018;
 3. Verification of Non-filing Letter from the IRS dated after October 1, 2018;
 4. A copy of IRS Form W-2 for each source of employment income received for tax year 2018 and,
 5. If self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of the individual's Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) and the U.S. income tax paid for tax year 2018
- Victim of Tax-Related Identity Theft**- must provide:
 1. A Tax Return DataBase View (TRDBV) transcript obtained from the IRS, or any other IRS tax transcript that includes all of the income and tax information required to be verified; **and**
 2. A statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that he/she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS is aware of the tax-related identity theft.

What you need to get an On-Line Transcript: 1) SSN # 2) date of birth 3) filing status and mailing address from latest tax return 4) access to your email account 5) your personal account# from a credit card, mortgage, home equity loan, home equity line of credit or car loan, and 6) a mobile phone with your name on the account.
