Important Note: The instructions below apply to the student and spouse, if the student is married. Notify the financial aid office if the student or spouse filed separate IRS income tax returns for 2019 or had a change in marital status after December 31, 2019.

 2. A copy of the IRS's approval of an extension beyond the automatic six-month extension for tax year 2019;
 3. Verification of Non-filing Letter from the IRS dated after October 1, 2019;
 4. A copy of IRS Form W-2 for each source of employment income received for tax year 2019 and,
 5. If self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of the individual's Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) and the U.S. income tax paid for tax year 2019.

Victim of Tax Administration Identity Theft – must provide:

1. A Tax Return DataBase View (TRDBV) transcript obtained from the IRS, or any other IRS tax transcript that includes all of the income and tax information required to be verified; **and**
2. A statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that he or she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS is aware of the tax-related identity theft.

A 2019 IRS Tax Return Transcript may be obtained through the:

- Get Transcript by MAIL– Go to IRS.gov under the Tools heading, click "Get Tax Transcript.", Click "Get Transcript by MAIL" Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and **NOT** the "IRS Tax Account Transcript."
- Get Transcript ONLINE- Go to www.IRS.gov, under the Tools heading, click "Get Tax Transcript", Click "Get Transcript ONLINE" Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and **NOT** the "IRS Tax Account Transcript."

- Mobile App – Get the IRS2GO app from your mobile device,

What you need to get an On-Line Transcript: 1) SSN # 2) date of birth 3) filing status and mailing address from latest tax return 4) access to your email account 5) your personal account # from a credit card, mortgage, home equity loan, home equity line of credit or car loan, and 6) a mobile phone with your name on the account.
