

INSTALLATION ACCESS PASS

Proceed to the Main Gate at the Marine Base Visitor's Center – Building 1012. You will need to fill out an application to register your vehicle. You must bring the following:

- Photo identification (current driver license) anyone with a Federal Limits Apply DL will need to provide a second form of identification such as a passport or passport card, etc.
- Current vehicle registration
- Current proof of insurance
- Copy of your Copper Mountain College class/course registration schedule/receipt. Schedules/receipts need to show start and end dates of course offered on the Marine Base.

Please be advised:

- The Visitor's Center will not issue your pass prior to the first day of class.
- Please allow one to two hours to obtain your pass.
- Your pass will need to be renewed after thirty days.
- The Visitor's Center will require CMC to fax or email a copy of your class schedule to verify your enrollment.


The Visitor's Center hours of operation are: 5:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
