Instructors!

All proposals are subject to an approval process. Upon completion, submission, and approval, we will work with instructors to design a schedule. Be sure to include a resume, short biography, course summary for advertisement purposes and any relevant certifications; it may help with the approval process.

The deadline for proposal submission is October 31, 2022.

Community Education Courses: Course length is at the discretion of the instructor; however, for the Spring 2023 semester your course may only be held between February 27th and May 17th.

Location Availability: Courses may be offered online or face-to-face for the Spring 2023 semester.

Student Enrollment and fees: The instructor determines the fee for the course. Copper Mountain College has a minimum class enrollment of three students for the class to run; however, the instructor may set a higher minimum enrollment. A student roster will be emailed to you prior to the first class.

Instructor Payment: Upon completion of the course, the instructor will receive 70% of the total student enrollment fees. An invoice will be emailed to you for your signature stating the number of students enrolled and the total amount of payment due.
