STEP I

GET YOUR CLASSES

- □ Apply to Copper Mountain College online at www.cmccd.edu
- Complete Orientation online through MyCMC Portal
- □ Contact Admissions and Records to schedule an appointment to complete your Student Education Plan (SEP)
- □ Complete the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) application at www.fafsa.gov; school code is: 035424
- □ Sign up for classes! You can do this online through your MyCMC portal or in person at Admissions and Records.

HELPFUL TIP: Get the classes you need by taking advantage of your priority registration.

Don't miss an important email! Download the Microsoft Outlook App to set up your CMC email on your phone. You will need your full CMC email. Hint: it's your portal username. Ex. username@student. cmccd.edu

STEP 2

GET YOUR BENEFITS

- □ Apply for your Veterans Educational Benefits via www.eBenefits.va.gov.
- □ Submit a copy of the following documents to Veteran Services:
 - DD 214
 - Education plan
 - Certificate of Eligibility (COE)
 - Prior Credit Form
- Submit Joint Services Transcript (JST) and ALL official college transcripts to Veterans Services in Student Services
- Verify your classes EVERY semester with a counselor and submit the signed approval form to Veterans Services

HELPFUL TIP: Enroll and submit approval form early so there isn't a delay in payment.

STEP 3

GET YOUR FINANCIAL AID

- Once you have submitted your FAFSA, visit My Self-Service Portal under the Financial Aid tab at MyCMC Portal to complete all documents
- □ Go to your MyCMC portal to select how you would like your financial aid disbursed
- Apply for CMC Scholarships between January and April at https://www.cmccd.edu/ current-students/ scholarship/

HELPFUL TIP: If you are denied financial aid, consider submitting an Income Adjustment Form.
