



Common Course Numbering (CCN)

Beginning in Fall 2025, the Common Course Numbering (CCN) system—mandated by the state under initiative AB 1111—will be implemented to simplify student transfers and establish uniform course numbering across all California Community Colleges.

Currently in Phase 1, the CCN initiative focuses on aligning course numbers for general education and transfer pathway courses. The system is designed to ensure that comparable courses across community colleges share the same course number, thereby streamlining the transfer process to fouryear institutions and helping students avoid accumulating excess credits.

Courses designated as part of the CCN system will include a "C" in their course numbers (e.g., ENG 003A will become ENGL C1000). Additionally, some subject area prefixes will change to meet statewide standards (e.g., PS will become POLS).

All changes—including updated course numbers and prefixes—will be **clearly noted in the class schedule** to help students identify and navigate the transition with ease.

California Community Colleges are determined to bring down the cost of textbooks. SR 1359 California Education Code 66406.9

Learning Modalities

Face-to-Face (F2F)

Online: Asynchronous (OAS)



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
