

2025-2026 Cost of Attendance

Copper Mountain College uses the cost of attendance (COA) when evaluating/awarding a student's financial aid. The *Cost of Attendance* is known as the student's "budget." It represents a school's best estimate of the costs a student will acquire during an academic year. The financial aid office calculates the student's unmet need/cost by subtracting the SAI (Student Aid Index) from the COA. Students are considered to have financial (unmet) need if their COA exceeds their SAI:

Unmet Need = Cost of Attendance - (SAI + other financial assistance awarded)

SAI is calculated from the data on a student's financial aid application.

- Loan Fees For student loan borrowers, actual or average loan origination and insurance may be assessed to increase their cost of attendance.
