Technological Literacy Matters at CMC!

Online learning is not just for online or hybrid classes! Any class may be web enhanced.

Many of our classes use Canvas and/or online sites such as MyMathLab, MyLab, MyProgrammingLab, or the textbook publisher's website for assignments, testing, homework, etc. Check the information on your class registration for your course material needs which may require an access card in addition to your textbook.

Common Course Numbering (CCN)

Beginning Fall 2025, the **Common Course Numbering (CCN)** system—mandated by the state under initiative AB 1111— was implemented to simplify student transfers and establish uniform course numbering across all California Community Colleges.

Currently in **Phase 1**, the CCN initiative focuses on aligning course numbers for general education and transfer pathway courses. The system is designed to ensure that comparable courses across community colleges share the same course number, thereby streamlining the transfer process to four-year institutions and helping students avoid accumulating excess credits.

Courses designated as part of the CCN system will include a "C" in their course numbers (e.g., ENG 003A will become ENGL C1000). Additionally, some subject area prefixes will change to meet statewide standards (e.g., PS will become POLS). All changes—including updated course numbers and prefixes—will be clearly noted in the class schedule to help students identify and navigate the transition with ease.


